They are separate — some parents are happy with a photograph but not a name, and that is a perfectly normal thing to ask for. **If you tick both**, we may put a photograph with your child's first name next to it. **We never publish surnames, addresses, birthdays or schools.**

What this means

- The club website is **public** — anyone can look at it.
- We only use photographs taken at the club or at chess events.
- We will not use your child's photograph in any advertising, or give it to anyone else.
- Photographs are taken off the website after **16 weeks** — about four months — so they do not stay online indefinitely.

We ask for your child's date of birth for two reasons: so we can wish them a happy birthday at the club, and so we can see how a child is doing for their age — some of our seven-year-olds play better than children several years older, and we like to recognise that. **Your child's birthday never goes on the website.** We ask for a phone number and an email address because they do different jobs: the phone is so we can reach you quickly if something happens at a session, and the email is how we let you know when something new goes on the website. **Neither is ever published, and we do not give them to anyone else.** We keep this form while your child comes to the club, and not after. ·
